Search for filesBorn in 1625, Thomas Jefferson lived in his family's home in Culpeper, Virginia, until the age of 13. His father, Peter Jefferson, died in 1659, leaving his mother, Elizabeth Trammell Jefferson, to raise her two young daughters, Mary and Elizabeth, on her own. She soon moved the family to a farm in Shadwell, a small and low-lying area on the James River. By age 17, Thomas Jefferson had left his mother and sisters and was living with his ailing grandfather. He then traveled to London and returned in 1667 to live with his father at Shadwell. He may have been able to leave Virginia because of the Indian massacre of 1622, known as Bacon's Rebellion, which forced many Virginians to move to other colonies. Young Thomas Jefferson's father died in 1676, and Thomas returned to live with his mother and sisters in Shadwell. Despite leaving the family home for several years, Thomas Jefferson never lost his deep connection to the area. In 1767, he purchased his neighbor's 10-acre (4 ha) plot of land and built a frame house on it. In 1769, he sold the land to his son-in-law, John Wayles, Sr., and moved the family to Tuckahoe, a small farm in a rural area near the Potomac River. In 1743, John Wayles, Sr., and Elizabeth Hemings, Thomas Jefferson's great-grandmother, married.
